Some of the matters which came before Church Council at this meeting is set out as follows – and is News to Share.

HOSTING OF PRESBYTERY:

It was pleasing to receive favourable reports of our Parish's experience of hosting Presbytery over the weekend 8-10 November. Thanks were expressed again to all who were involved.

SERVICE OF RECOGNITION AND APPRECIATION:

Arrangements are in hand for this Service on 8th December at 9.00am to recognise and express appreciation to Rev Glenn and Anne, as they prepare to retire and leave us, after 8½ years of ministry in Rockhampton South. A Love Gift will be presented to them.

At the same service recognition and appreciation will be expressed to Mrs Lyn Thomasson our Parish Office Secretary who retires after 21 years of service. Again a Love Gift will be presented.

CONGREGATION MEETING:

A Meeting of the Congregation will follow this Service of Recognition on 8th December.

TERMINATION OF PLACEMENT:

Following the recent announcement, by the Presbytery Minister at each of the Services at the South Rockhampton Church, of the termination of the Placement of Rev Jennifer Roberts, arrangements are to be made for suitable recognition of a Service and Farewell for Rev Jen, Robert, Grace and Molly.

JOINT NOMINATING COMMITTEE:

ASBESTOS AUDIT:

Treasurer Brendan outlined some of the changes being made to banking arrangements as introduced by Synod.

TRANSFER OF MEMBERSHIP:

Church Council received the transfer of membership from the Capricorn Coast Parish of Mr Don and Mrs Mary Pope.

SOUTH ROCKHAMPTON CHAPLAINCY COMMITTEE:

Church Council would be delighted to hear from persons interested in being our representative on the South Rockhampton Chaplaincy Committee. This Committee supports and encourages the work of the Chaplains appointed to the Schools in this area.

REPAIR OF PULPIT BIBLE:

It was reported that the Pulpit Bible which is located on a stand on the Communion Table has been rebound and repaired by City Printing Works at no cost to the Parish.

CHURCH PEW CUSHIONS:

It was also reported that the Pew Cushions have been recovered. The material and labour donated by Aurilea Augustine. This was undertaken and completed in time for the Presbytery Meetings which were conducted in the Church.

PARISH OFFICE SECRETARY:

This position has been advertised, applications received and interviews conducted.

PARTNERS IN MISSION 2014:

Worship and Evangelism Committee has reported that plans are in place for next year's program. The Celebration Service will be 4th August. The guest preacher to be Rev Dr Malcolm Coombes of Trinity College and Professor of New Testament Studies.
